Royal Thai Embassy in Vienna
Subject: Additional Requirements for
Non-Immigrant ‘O-A’ (Long Stay) Visa Application

Pursuant to the Resolution of the Council of Ministers of Thailand, dated 2 April B.E. 2562 (2019), approving in principle for the stipulation of health insurance as an additional requirement for Non-Immigrant ‘O-A’ (Long Stay) visa application, the Royal Thai Embassy in Vienna has introduced the following requirements for the said visa application:

1. The applicant must be medically insured for the entire period of stay in Thailand with the following coverage:

- *Outpatient benefit* with a sum insured of not less than 40,000 THB or 1,300 EUR per year, and
- *Inpatient benefit* with a sum insured of not less than 400,000 THB or 13,000 EUR per year.

2. In addition to the existing documentary requirements, the applicant must submit the following:

2.1 Health insurance policy document issued by a Thai or foreign insurance company, stating that the applicant is medically insured for the period and with coverage as mentioned in paragraph 1:

(a) In case of a *foreign insurance company*, the applicant must submit the original insurance policy document with 2 copies;

(b) In case of a *Thai insurance company*, the applicant must submit 2 copies of the insurance policy document or, if available, the original insurance policy document with 2 copies. *A list of Thai insurance companies participating in the scheme can be found here: <https://longstay.tgia.org>*

2.2 Foreign Insurance Certificate as stipulated by the Office of Insurance Commission and Health Insurance of Thailand, which must be completed, signed and stamped by the insurance company. *The form can be downloaded here: <https://longstay.tgia.org>*

The above requirements will be effective **from 31 October 2019.**
