Royal Thai Embassy in Vienna Subject: Additional Requirements for Non-Immigrant 'O-A' (Long Stay) Visa Application

Pursuant to the Resolution of the Council of Ministers of Thailand, dated 2 April B.E. 2562 (2019), approving in principle for the stipulation of health insurance as an additional requirement for Non-Immigrant 'O-A' (Long Stay) visa application, the Royal Thai Embassy in Vienna has introduced the following requirements for the said visa application:

- 1. The applicant must be medically insured for the entire period of stay in Thailand with the following coverage:
 - Outpatient benefit with a sum insured of not less than 40,000 THB or 1,300 EUR per year, and
 - *Inpatient benefit* with a sum insured of not less than 400,000 THB or 13,000 EUR per year.
- 2. In addition to the existing documentary requirements, the applicant must submit the following:
- 2.1 <u>Health insurance policy document</u> issued by a Thai or foreign insurance company, stating that the applicant is medically insured for the period and with coverage as mentioned in paragraph 1:
- (a) In case of a *foreign insurance company*, the applicant must submit the original insurance policy document with 2 copies;
- (b) In case of a *Thai insurance company*, the applicant must submit 2 copies of the insurance policy document or, if available, the original insurance policy document with 2 copies. *A list of Thai insurance companies participating in the scheme can be found here: https://longstay.tgia.org*
- 2.2 Foreign Insurance Certificate as stipulated by the Office of Insurance Commission and Health Insurance of Thailand, which must be completed, signed and stamped by the insurance company. The form can be downloaded here: https://longstay.tgia.org

The above requirements will be effective from 31 October 2019.
